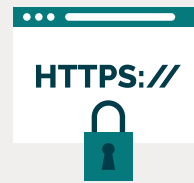

But as retailers continually add ways to shop and pay online, criminals find new ways to pinch hundreds off their marks.

To prevent scammers from taking advantage of you, do these things before you shop from a retailer that's new to you.

1. Study the Seller's Website

What does the item cost?

How old is the brand's website?

Is the website secure?

Does the brand offer any contact methods, like a phone number, address or email address?

How thorough is the website?

2. Look for Authorized Resellers

3. Research Beyond the Storefront

4. Use a Protected Payment Method
