Beware of QR Code Scams: Protect Yourself from Fraud

QR codes have become increasingly popular and simplify tasks like accessing websites or paying for services, but they also make it easier for scammers to steal your personal information.

Scammers use tactics like placing malicious QR codes over legitimate ones, using short links to hide harmful URLs, requesting money for fake payments, sending surprise packages with suspicious QR codes, and tampering with codes to mimic real ones.

HOW TO STAY SAFE:

- Only scan QR codes from trusted sources.
- Verify the link by checking the website's URL before entering any sensitive information.
- Keep your phone up to date with the latest operating system.
- Pay using a credit card when using a QR code.
- Be cautious of unsolicited QR codes in public spaces or emails.
